In 2012 Ilda Garrine Franca and Jose Jamisse Gume graduated from Methodist-related Africa University in Zimbabwe, thanks to scholarships they received from Desert Skies.

Today they are working in their home community at the Chicuque Rural Hospital which was established more than 100 years ago by Methodist missionaries. This hospital is now operated by the government of Mozambique and the United Methodist Church. Ilda and Jose are the principal providers of mental health services at the hospital. They each see about twenty outpatients a day as well as seeing inpatients. Counseling AIDS patients is a top priority.

Ilda and Jose are both very active in the Chicuque United Methodist Church. Ilda sings in the choir and participates in United Methodist Women. Jose is active in the church at Chicuque and is the lay leader for the Southern Mozambique Conference. He attended General Conference last year.

Letter from Bishop Bob

Dear Members and Friends of the Desert Southwest Conference,

Peace to you in the name and spirit of Jesus Christ!

On Tuesday, June 6, an early morning fire gutted and destroyed the sanctuary of Zion UMC in Las Vegas. DS Dan Morley and I visited the church and met with pastor Larry Johnson and members of the Zion church family.

As we drove up to the scene in the photos below, I was not sure what the spirit of the gathered group would be. What I did find was that even in the aftermath of the destruction of their beloved church, the congregation was already focused on getting back on their feet and planning for the future. A deep sense of hope and trust in God's graciousness was evident.

I am reminded of the power of our connection. We give thanks to the DSC Disaster Response Team with Pastor Fred Heggestad at the helm. The Conference team was present in force to begin the clean up on the day of the fire and will walk with the congregation as they move forward.

As I asked how it was with their soul, they referred to blessings received from the community. They felt that the fire has brought them together as a church family. And they knew God was present with them.

I am reminded of a strong word from the Scriptures. In I Corinthians 12 we read, "If one part hurts, every other part is involved in the hurt, and in the healing. If one part flourishes, every other part enters into the exuberance." (The Message)
