# HUNGER KNOWS NO SEASON

A reminder to all that 815 million people around the world will go to bed hungry. This is 11% of the world population and a decrease from the 23% twenty years ago. On <u>Sunday, April 8th</u> Desert Skies will have an opportunity to be a part of decreasing that percentage even more. More than half of the needless deaths of children under 5 are from hunger-related causes. 66 million primary-school-age children go to school hungry.

**RISE AGAINST HUNGER** provides food and aid to the world's most vulnerable people. In 2016 Rise Against Hunger packaged and sent 67,000,000 meals to hungry children and adults in 43 countries. As our congregation participates in Rise Against Hunger we are part of a global movement to end hunger. The goal of Rise Against Hunger is "zero hunger by 2030".

At 29 cents per meal, a gift of \$29.00 will provide 100 meals for hungry children in one of the world's poorest countries. <u>HOW</u> <u>MANY MEALS WILL YOU PROVIDE?</u>
