

### **Help Support The Inn Project**

Dear friends.

On Sunday afternoon, January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019, from 3pm to 5pm at the Loft Cinema on Speedway in Tucson, Noor Alsabahi will be sharing her story in film and in person. Noor is being hosted by St Mark's United Methodist Church.

Noor is part of a documentary film called *Something Like Home* produced by Duolingo, a free foreign language education company based in Pittsburg, Pennsylvania. The short 36 minute film highlights not only Noor's journey as a refugee, but also the journey of 3 others who were forced to flee their native country to find a new home in another land.

Noor's story of life as an Iraqi born woman, a Syrian resident, and then refugee into Turkey, is one that is inspiring. (I guarantee it will pull at your heartstrings!) The Church and Society group at St Mark's along with Adult Spiritual Growth have decided that as a border town in the United States, this story should be made available to the public. Having the church as a sponsor we hope will remind the community that the United Methodist Church is truly a place of Open Hearts, Open Minds, and Open Doors. We will remind Tucson that we are all God's children!

We will sell tickets for \$5 each. The theater seats 398 people, is the lower level main theater (no steps) and we hope to "SELL OUT!" All proceeds from the event will go to the Inn Project here in town. First United Methodist Church has become a haven for refugees in transition and they can use the dollars for updating a space that is currently getting much use!

How can you help? Please promote this event and plan to attend yourself if you are free that day! If you have it within your budget to aid in anyway, it would be appreciated!
