# LENT

Lent is an opportunity to go deeper in relationship to God through discipleship in Christ. For many, these 40 days set aside leading up to Holy Week and Easter, help us nurture our spirit and tend our soul. This journey can feed us toward living with intention and give us deeper purpose. I invite you to find ways to make this time meaningful and engaging:

<u>"He Chose the Nails"-Beginning Sunday, March 3, 8:30 am-</u> Every gift from God reveals his love, but no gift reveals his love more than the gifts of the cross. These gifts came not wrapped in paper but in passion. In this five-session video Bible study, Max Lucado explores the many gifts that Christ provided to us at his crucifixion.
