Rev. Mark Conrad, South District Superintendent, will convene the annual charge/church conference for the purpose of conducting the business of the charged as required by the church. As a charge/church conference, all members are encouraged to attend and have a vote. Following the charge/church conference, members and friends are invited to a congregational meeting. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss how our congregation will navigate these challenging times. The Church Conversation Session is estimated to run 60-90 minutes.

On Tuesday, October 29, the Church Council voted unanimously to send this statement of inclusion to the Church Conference on November 19 for final approval. We appreciate the feedback we received from the church at large as we drafted a statement that says in writing who we say we are verbally...and because of that feedback, our statement is actually in two parts. The first is a short, succinct statement that will appear on our sign and on our website, etc.:

## DSUMC : We are fully inclusive and ALL are welcome!

What that means is also important for those who are looking for a welcoming, inclusive church, so that will be available on our web page under About Us, linked to the shorter, more concise welcoming statement. It reads as follows:

Desert Skies United Methodist Church of Tucson, Arizona welcomes people of every race, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, marital status, age, physical and mental ability, ethnicity, national origin, economic station, and political affiliation to full participation in the life of our community.

Full participation in the life of our community means that all members, without exception, are fully eligible to participate in the benefits and responsibilities of church membership, including communion, baptism, marriage, ordination and all offices and positions of leadership.

We look forward to seeing you all on Tuesday, November 19, at 6:30 pm as we do the brief business meeting and then enter into conversation with our District Superintendent about who we are as a church and where we are headed!
