Our Lenten Sermon Series: Falling Upward: A Spirituality for the Two Halves of Life begins on Ash Wednesday, February 26th and runs through Maundy Thursday, April 9th.

Richard Rohr speaks of the two halves of our spiritual life. The first half is when we are formed and forming; the second half begins after trials and tragedies, trauma and temptations push and pull us into reforming, renewing, restoring, rewriting our script and story.

The first half includes what God provides what we need to survive. The second half begins as God guides us forward to thrive. Christian Century writes, "The message of Falling Upward is straightforward and bracing: the spiritual life is not static. You will come to a crisis in your life, and after the crisis, if you are open to it, you will enter a space of spiritual refreshment, peace and compassion that you could not have imagined before." This Lent, we will use the book "Falling Upward" as a framework for exploring our spirituality.

Bucket Brigade is Back!

Thanks to Desert Skies' amazing participation in assembling Flood Buckets last spring, our Church was able to ship 200 completed Cleaning Kit buckets to the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR).

We will focus again on disaster relief for our Lent family service project. Mini-buckets will be distributed the next two Sundays in March at our 3 services. We need all hands on deck to insure success!

UMCOR has an urgent and ongoing need for supplying their Western Distribution Center with Cleaning Kits for victims of flooding in the U.S. We are again asking each family to "fill one mini-bucket" with your change/cash collections from home throughout the 40 days of Lent. 100% of the proceeds will cover the cost of the Cleaning Kit supplies, at \$45 per bucket. This year our church goal is assembly of 250 cleaning kits. **The filled mini-buckets are due back on Palm Sunday, April 5. Our Bucket Brigade assembly will take place right after church on Sunday April 19.** All hands on deck!

We'll be observing the World Day of Prayer on Friday, March 6 between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. at St John on The Desert, located at 2695 N Houghton Rd in Tucson. This is not a formal worship service, but rather, an opportunity for folks to travel through our sanctuary visiting various "prayer stations" at their own pace. Our Prayer Stations will include:

- 1. World and USA Prayers: Pray for a part of the world or the USA in need using pins placed on a world map.
- 2. Pray Like a Child: Using a Blessings Catcher.
- 3. **Prayer for Victims of Gun Violence**: Candles lit for those impacted by gun violence with information on the Soul Box project.
- 4. Pennies Prayer: Prayer can be as simple as the penny in your pocket.
- 5. Paper Chain Prayers: Thank you prayers written and looped, then draped on a cross.
- 6. Labyrinth: A spiritual walk along our outdoor desert landscape labyrinth.
- 7. **Prayer Warriors**: Folks from St John will be available for those who need prayers spoken on their behalf.

There will be take-away prayers at all stations

We ask that you share the news of this event to the members of your faith community either in your newsletter or in your weekly bulletin.

We hope to greet you on March 6 anytime between the hours of 4pm and 6pm.
