Casa Maria Soup Kitchen serves many of Tucson's underprivileged, now more than ever due to effects of the Covid-19 pandemic. Early each morning, coffee and donated pastries warm up many of the homeless. Soup, 350 bag lunches and food to feed 50 families are provided daily. The Missions and Social Concerns Committee supports Casa Maria monthly by providing necessary supplies.

From Your DSUMC COVID Vaccination Team

There is so much information out there concerning the vaccine, how to make an appointment and the details of sites administering the vaccine, and Desert Skies would like to give you this information in one location.

The first step is to register your eligibility at https://webcms.pima.gov/cms/One.aspx?portalled=169&pageld=690372. This site will also give you links to the different locations. When filling out the initial survey, there will be a place to list disabilities as a sub-group for every level. When you complete your registration, you will see a message that once your eligibility is verified, you will receive email instructions from the site you selected. This may take three working days or more. The Pima County phone number for assistance in registering for the COVID vaccine is (520) 222-0119.

If you want to schedule the vaccine at TMC, be sure to have a MyChart account to streamline the process. If you have an activated MyChart account, once you have registered on the Pima site, you may be able to schedule an appointment through your MyChart before you receive an email. 
